Orientation for the Leader

Welcome to the joy of leading preschool children. As a leader you need to commit to setting a high standard. Here are 5 principles to help you achieve that goal.

1. Personal

In order to share Jesus with others, even small children, you must have a personal connection with Jesus Christ. Personal devotional time, focus on prayer and openness to the Sprit's leading are all crucial to being a master teacher.

2. Excellence

Take your leadership responsibility as a God given challenge. Be reliable, and prepared. The teachers most likely not give more than you expect of them. Set a high standard by modeling behavior. God has given you these children for a very short period of time, so use it well. "If the teacher is properly prepared, every moment can be used to profit. The active minds of the children should be kept constantly employed." *Counsels on Sabbath School Work* p. 117

3. Organization

Have all the materials for the program readily available. There will always be last minute emergencies. You must be prepared to have a substitute for yourself or one of the teachers. All supplies should be kept at the meeting location, so the program will not come to a halt.

4. Nurturing

The best prepared leader will not have success with young children if she do not show a loving spirit. Get to know the children in your class and form a warm bond with them.

5. Parent Interaction

Do not be discouraged if all your parent do not take the time to work with their children at first. Be diplomatic and non-confrontational in explaining the importance of their role in the program. If they repeatedly come unprepared, encourage the teachers to call them 3-4 days before the next meeting. Remember that alienating the parent will only cause them not to bring their child at all.
