

Opening Program

It is important to start on time, and the opening exercises set the pace for the rest of the program. Do not drag them out. Don't worry if they don't know everything at first.

Dialog: Welcome to our Discovery Club meeting. I'm glad all of you are here today. To begin, let's stand up with our hands on our hearts like this and face the flag. (Don't spend the time to teach this in class, they will learn as they go, and encourage the parents to teach it at home. In the beginning it will be just the teachers saying it)
